

Transcription of Historic Loan and Check

(Please note, this is transcribed verbatim, including grammatical and spelling errors)

Loan:

Sir,

The Directors having consented to discount for me to the extent of Eight thousand Dollars payable in Six Months on Condition that I deposit to that amount Treasury Warrants as a Security for the punctual performance of my Engagement, I herein enclose to you my note of this date payable to the President and Directors of the Bank of North America in six months for Eight thousand Dollars, and I further enclose three warrants dated 27th February 1789 signed by Samuel Osgood and Walter Livingston payable to Joseph Hawell Juror Esq. postmaster general and directed to Michael Hillegas Esq. Treasurer of the United States of America.

Accounting together to the sum of Eight Thousand four hundred and twenty two 47/90 Dollars, but it is understood that I am to be at liberty at any period before the expiration of Six Months to withdraw the said warrants upon depositing in lieu thereof other securities of equal value to the same amount, and I authorize you in case of any failure of punctuality on my part as to the payment of the note, to make sale of the securities so deposited, in order to reimburse the Bank for their Advance.
